Well I understand you are still in San Antonio so I will write you there. I have been writing to you at Cuero since I thought you would have returned by now.

I have just returned from a very good football game between two Navy teams and I enjoyed it very much.

Maybe you would like to know something of what I do in the Navy. I get up at 5 o'clock and go to chow then we go to a P. T. class. Later we return and take a shower and clean up and go drill for a while at 12:30 and

eat chow again. at 2 we go to lectures
or drill until 4:30, at which
time we knock off for the day.

The camp isn't very hard but
they keep us busy.
