It's been a long time since I've written you so I will write you both since at the same time.

Well the big game is here tomorrow when the team here plays N. C. Pre-flight, which is undefeated and has beaten Navy, Otto Graham, Spec Saunders and Elroy Hirsch. It should be a good game and I am looking forward to it. I would also like to see or hear the Devo Rio game. Please keep on sending me the clippings.

~~So~~ I don't know if I told you ~~remember~~ before but I took out \$10,000 insurance policy and told them to send the policy to you. It costs \$6.40 a month and can be kept forever. and the beneficiary can

be changed. After paying this for
30 years the Co. will pay you
\$50 for the rest of your life,
if you like.

I have been assigned to
Radio school in Memphis. I
wanted ordnance but my appetite
was more for Radio so I get
it. It may be good or bad. Only
about 10 or 15% get Radio
from here and about 40% fail
out of Radio school. Most of
the guys wanted Radio and got
ordnance and I wanted ordnance
and got Radio. I hope well I
pass the school I'll be satisfied.
