Well I don't know how long it's been since I last wrote you but I guess it's about time to write again, although there is not much that I have to write about.

My mail is kind of messed up. I received a letter from dad yesterday dated May 20 and one today dated May 17. I also received a letter from both of my grandmothers today dated May 17 + 18.

I imagine there are lots of letters I never will get so repeat the important events in ^{my} letters.

I was very sorry to hear about Fritz Gohke being killed in Germany. He was a really swell kid. I guess he is the first one of my class to be killed in the war. I hope we will hear from Paul. I never have been able to believe that he was dead.

I get the old Football fever every time I receive a letter from you talking about it. I was glad to hear about Gerald and I believe he is busy in getting to go to Texas. He is young and will probably be able to play two years if I am not

mistaken. I will really be glad to get back to college again. I think I will really appreciate it. I don't know if I will ~~every~~ ever be able to play ball again but I would like to try.

I like being attached to the Marines and I wish that I could transfer to the Marine Corps. I don't know how to go about it but I am going to look into it.

I don't guess I will ever hear from my application to get back into Air Corps. I was looking for a copy of the letter in my records and it went in Feb 8. Some boys I know in M.G. who were in V-5 before who got their orders and went back to the states, but I guess they don't want me.
