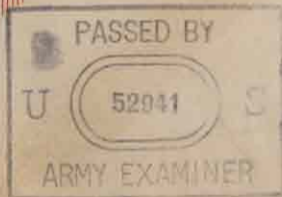

I am standing watch over some "gooks" supervising their digging of a pipeline and I thought I might as well be writing a letter while they are digging.

I have one gook who speaks Spanish and I tell him in Spanish what I want done and he tells the rest.

I have been surprised to hear so much from you about how interesting my letters are as I had imagined that they were rather dull. (A gook is looking over my shoulder now and watching me write.)

I haven't been spending much time thinking what to write but I

have been just writing down what comes into my mind. I have not received any paper except for a few April records and I would like to have any clippings you have that might interest me.

I haven't gotten any clippings of any paper except for a few April records for a long time. I haven't gotten any packages and I expect there's still in the States.

101 are at Military Government 101 headquarters. We have a nice "Cave" hall built and many of the tents have floors and electric lights and the rest of the tents

are having floor and lights put in them  
The pipeline I mentioned earlier was  
for an officer's shower.

I am getting to get more bored with  
this place every day and I would like  
to move on, but I don't ~~yet~~ think there's  
any chance of that for awhile yet.  
It has been very hot and dusty  
here for the, ~~last~~ few weeks. I  
don't think there's a place in the  
world more dusty than it is  
here. ~~Oh!~~

I wish that you won't worry  
about me any more and that's all  
for now.
