Clasharova obituary
5 September 23, 1945

Dear Folks,
yesterday I heard from both of you
for the 1st time in about a week. The
mail service is getting worse all the
time because of the bad flying
weather and the deployment of
the main force of mail planes
to taking troops and supplies
to Japan and Korea. All the
Army officers here have left
from Korea.

I have taken ten rolls of
film but have not had any
of it developed. I may send
it to you with a
parashut and other things.

If you can find out
Jimmy Fowler's and Frank
Booth's address I will be
able to find the. Try to find
out the name of the field Frank
is at. Some of the big ones are
Yontan, Kadena, Naha etc.

I have heard that the court system
is to be done away with and
that after a while they are going
to release everyone with two years
which will put me out next
September.
