Dear folks,

We have moved our camp into where some Seabees have moved out we have taken over all their equipment and it is really nice here. I am a switchboard operator and also am in charge of the P. A. system.

There was really a lot of damage here during the storm and several persons are dead and missing. They also had several men killed here when some dumb fool down at the Naval operating base set off some dynamite. I could go on and on with all the fool stunts they have pulled here.

They are using American planes + ships
to take Jap P. W.'s back to Japan,
while American men who have
enough points for discharge wait
3 + 4 months for a ship to go
home. They are also providing American
food to feed these people
and they permit making any
attempt to put them back
in an economy or make them
self providing. They are also
giving them shoes and clothing
that many poor families at home
would be glad to have.
Military Govt. is doing practically
nothing here now and the Marine
Colonel in charge can't make
a move without consulting
Washington. one
