BUT I AM GOING NEXT WEEK IF THE WEATHER ISNT BAD AGAIN.
I WILL PROBABLY LEAVE NEXT FRIDAY OR SAT.

I HAVENT HAD ANY MAIL FROM YOU FOR LONGER THAN USUAL BUT
I GUESS THATS BECAUSE OF THE BAD FLYING WEATHER . ITS AHS
BEEN RAINING FORTHE LAST FEW DAYS AND TODAY IS THE FIRST
GOOD DAY IN ABOUT A WEEK . . TODAY IS SUNDAY AND I CANT GO

WRITING YOU THIS LETTER .
