I stay in Sunday again and sit  
back at my letter writing job.  
Went to church this morning. Chaplain  
as usual had about a 20 minute  
service mostly singing. (I don't  
think that he can talk)

I have been reading a lot lately.  
I have just finished reading "The  
Republic" a history book by Charles  
B. Beard. I have been reading up books  
right and left at the rate of 1 book  
every 2 or 3 days so that is  
about all that I have to do.

We had a party last night and  
had several Red Cross girls as hostesses  
and had 3 general and 2 admirals  
who dropped in with a couple of  
Marine Colonels who ~~dropped~~ to  
make a speech. I think they are  
trying to get us to react, but  
they're not having much luck.
