DEAR FOLKS,

I RECEIVED THREE LETTERS FROM YOU ALL DATED ON JAN 9 YESTERDAY.
I STILL HAVENT BEEN ABLE TO LOCATE HADLEY. I CALLED THE NAVAL
ISLAND DIRECTORY AND THEY DADNT HAVE HIM LISTED . OF COURSE, HE
HASENT BEEN HERE LONG AND THEY ^{might} NOT HAVE BEEN UP TO DATE .

WE STILL HAVENT HEARD ANYTHING MORE ABOUT THE ARMY TAKING OVER MG
BUT ARE STILL HOPING. -- IT IS MY OWN OPION ION THAT 10 MEN WHO
KNOW MILITARY GOVT MATTERS WOULD BE ABLE TO RUN MG HERE WITH THE
HELP OF A MP BATTALION. AS IT IS NOW THERE ARE 1500 NAVY MEN IN MG
NOT COUNTING A BATTALION OF MPS AND SEVERL ARMY INTERPRETERS.
MOST OF THE BUISNESS THEY DO HERE IS SOME THING TO DO WITH THE
MG PERSONELL RATHERE THAN THE CIVILIANS. NOT OVER 10 MEN IN MG DO
ANY WORK OF ANY IMPORTANCE IN MG WORK. I WITH ALL THERE BIG SHOTS
AND COLLEGE PROFESSORS THEY HAVE BEEN HERE 10 MONTHS AND THEY STILL
HAVE NO ECONOMIC SYSTEM WHAT SO EVER . ALL WE ARE DOING ARE FEEDING
THESE PEOPLE , CLOTHING THEM AND KEEPING THE TROOPS AWAY FROM THEM .
THEY ARE THE HAPPIEST PEOPLE IN THE WORLD . THEY DO NO WORK AND DONT
HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT A THING. TH Y WONT EVEN LET THEM PLANT ANY CROPS
WE WILL BE FEEDING THESE PEOPLE FOR THE REST OF THEIR LIVES IF
SOMETHING ISNT DONE SOON. AM ERICANS ARE SUCKERS ANYWAY.
