MOST OF THE NAVY'S YEOMEN HAVE ENOUGH POINTS TO GET OUT ON THIS DROP SINCE MOST OF THEM CAME IN EARLY. IT LOOKS LIKE THE ARMY WILL HAVE TO TAKE OVER NOW, BECAUSE THERE WONT BE ENOUGH PEOPLE TO RUN THIS PLACE.

I RECEIVED THE LETTER YOU WROTE ON THE BACK OF FRANK FRITZ'S LETTER THIS AFTERNOON. I HOPE THAT YOU WILL BE ABLE TO FIND A PLACE FOR ME TO STAY.
