DEAR FOLKS,
THERES NOT ANYTHING NEW EXCEPT YHAT I HAVENT GOTTEN ANY RECENT MAIL
FROM YOU IN OVER A WEEK . I GUESS THAT IT WILL GET HERE PRETTYSON
, THOUGH.

THEY LOWERED THE POINTS TO 28 IN MAY. IT LOOKS LIKE THAT I WILL
BE HOME ABOUT JULY 1. THEY SAY THAT ON JUNE 1 THAT ALL POINTS
FOR ALL RATES WILL BE THE SAME. IF THYE CONTINUE TO LOWER
THE POINTS AT 2 A MONTH THAT MEANS THAT TEY WILL BE DOWN TO 240
JULY 1 AND I WILL HAVE 241/2 ON THAT DATE. EVERY UNIT EXCEPT
MG HAS BEEN SENDING THERE MEN HOME 45 DAYS BEFORE THEY ARE
ELIGIBLE FOR DISCHARGE. MG HAS BEEN HOLDING THEM UNTIL 22
DAYS BEFORE THEY ARE ELIGIBLE. IF THEY CHANGE IT FOR MG I
WILL LEAVE HERE ABOUT THE MIDDLE OF MAY BUT IF THEY CONTINUE TO
DO AS THEY HAVE IN THE PAST I WONT LEAVE UNTILL LATE IN JUNE.

I DONT KNOW WHEN I WILL BE ABLE TO GO TO SHANGHAI BUT IT WILL
PROBABLY BE ABOUT 2 MONTHS. I GUESS THAT NOW THAT THE ARMY
ISNT TAKING COVER MG I WILL REMAIN HERE ON OKI UNTIL
IT IS TIME FOR ME TO GO HOME.

BE SURE AND LET ME KNOW WHEN YOU GET MY CHECK FOR 550DOLLARS
AND LET ME KNOW WHAT YOU DO WITH IT .

NOW IS THE TIME FOR ALL GOOD MEN TO COME TO THE AID OF THEIR COUNTRY
