DEAR FOLKS,
HERE I AM BACK WRITING A LETTER. I RECEIVED ONE FROM YOU TODAY DATED FEB 11. I HOPE THAT YOU HAVE GOTTEN MY CHECK BY THIS TIME BE SURE AND LET ME KNOW WHEN YOU GET IT.

ANOTHER ~~XENX~~ BUNCH OF BOYS WENT HOME TODAY. I HAVE IT FIGURED OUT THAT I HAVE A 107 MORE DAYS LEFT ON THIS ROCK. THATS A MIGHTY LONG TIME WHEN YOU SEE ALL YOUR FRIENDS GOING HOME.

I HOPE THAT SOMETHING WILL HAPEN THAT WILL MAKE ME LEAVE SOONER THAN THAT BUT I DONT KNOW WHAT IT COULD BE. I STILL HAVENT RECEIVED THE TU CATALOG THAT YOU SENT ME BY FIRST CLASS MAIL.

I WISH THAT I COULD GO INTO HIBERNATION AND WAKE UP ABOUT THREE MONTHS FROM NOW. I WISH THAT I COULD GET TRANSFERRED TO SOMEPLACE ELSE IF WE HAD ANYTHING TO DO OUR TIME WOULD PASS MUCH FASTER.

I ~~ENXX~~ WILL REALLY BE LONESOME IN ABOUT 2 1/2 WEEKS WHEN THE LARGE MAJORITY OF THE BOYS THAT I HAVE BEEN WITH FOR OVER A YEAR WILL GO HOME. THEIR ARE VERY FEW OF THE ORIGINAL FELLOWS IN MIL GOVY LEFT. THEY HAVE GOTTEN A BUNCH OF SEA BEES AS REPLACEMENTS AND THEY HAVE PROVED TO BE THE DIRTIEST STUPIDEST BUNCH THAT I HAVE RUN INTO IN THE NAVY. OF COURSE ALL OF THEM ARENT THAT WAY BUT A LOT OF THEM ARE.

THE MAIL SITUATION IS A LL FOULED UP AS USUAL. I GET ONE OF YOUR LETTERS IN 10 AS DAYS AND ONE IN 30.
