Dear Folks ,

Well its Sunday morning again and I am at work at my new job which I like pretty well mainly because I am learning something new. As I mentioned before in a letter that I was contemplating starting to work on the teletype , I think that you should know what I mean. I work twenty-four hours off and eight hours on. I like the job pretty well because as I said before I am learning something new .

I went to see a movie last night and got soaking wet , I was already wet so I decided to stay and see the movie . It turned out to be a good movie and I enjoyed it . The name of it was " AND THEN THERE WERE NONE" . I usually dont go to movies when it looks like rain but I did last night .

I hope that you have received my check for 550<sup>00</sup> . I imagine that you have but if not let me know since I had it registered. I guess that I have about four months to go before I become once more a free man but I hope for sooner than that . If they come out with something that would force the comands to send men home 45 days before they are eligible i would really be happy. As it is now they send them 22 days before they are eligible and they can send them 45 if the co's agree . AS it is now I will be eligible July 1 and will leave here about June 8 to go to NOB and wait for transportation home . The journey home would take about 15 days . Then I should be out sometime in early July. I am hoping for a good break though.
