I received one letter from you yesterday I thought that that would be the only one for this week. However, I dropped by the office after church this morning and found three more waiting for me. I am glad to know that I will probably be able to find a place in which to live in Austin.

I am still hoping to be home by the 15 of June but I doubt if I will be. You can expect me anytime between 15 June and 15 July. I will probably call you when I get to the west coast.

I read an article in the Feb 25 edition of LIFE magazine. I hope that you have read it. I am glad to see that they are finally publishing a little bit about this hierarchy in the armed forces. As yet all the stuff that I have seen on the caste system has been about the army. What about the Navy. I can assure you that the Navy has one that the Army can't even compare with. It all amounts to the fact that they were gentlemen and we were dogs and they carried it just a little too far for their own good. I think that in the coming years that one would really be sorry to admit that he was an officer in this war. There are too many men against them. If you think that the Germans are arrogant you should see some of these officers. No one said anything about it much during the war but its really coming out now.

Life here is very dull as usual. Its still raining every day and I guess that it will until I leave. Nothing much about to write and nothing to do. Its a ~~dirty~~ dirty shame that they have to keep so many men here on this rock with nothing to do.

I cant think of anything else to write so I guess that I had better close.
