Dear Folks:

Back again writing a letter and have finally gotten a fairly decent typewriter .

Maybe I will be able to type a little better with this one.

A big draft of fellows is leaving tomorrow. They are getting to go about 2 days early as a ship is waiting to go and isnt filled up they will leave Okie on the date that ordinarily they would leave Headquarters and are getting a lucky break as they will probably get home in time to be discharged on the date they are supposed to be . My friend Frank Scanio from Temple is on this draft and will probably call you when he gets home. --- I hope that I get a break like he did but I dont think I am that lucky.

It has let up raining for a few days and today we have nice weather . I hope that it stays this way. Its been a little chilly here for the past two days . You never can tell about this weather.

I have received all of your easter cards and appreciate them very much . It wont seem quite like easter out here but I will at least have the knowledge that I will soon be going home, which is some comfort.

I guess that you are buying all the clothes that you can for me. I hope that they will become a little easier to buy. The movie last night was fairly good , "Confidential Agent "

This letter has been interrupted due to the necessity of sending a teletype message but I am back at the typewriter now pounding out this letter to you via ari mail.

I am all ready to go home any time that they want to send me.

I cant think of anything to write about or thin about except that I want to go home .
