Dear Folks:

Mail seems to be coming through a little better now ; I received one letter from you yesterday and four today . I was very glad to get them as reading material is getting very low out here .

I have a very sore throat . I am still working and I dont seem to have a cold and I don t feel badly at all except for the throat . I took some pills and gargled with salt water . I suppose that it will go away sooner or later.

I havent received the watch yet but I suppose that I will get it sooner or later . I may be able to sell it . If I can get the right price , will sell.

I now have less than a month before I go to NoB to await transportation home.

The days are going by slowly but surely . I can hardly wait to get out of this "avy .

I am glad to see that the caste system in the Army is getting lot of publicity in the newspapers . I dont see why they dont start some sort of similiar investigation in the Navy s system which in my opinion is much worse than the Army 's .

I can think of very little and must apologize for the shortness of this letter.

There seems to be very little to write about out here that would interest you.
