Dear Folks:

I received three letters from you this morning dated April 23 24 and 25 consecutively. I think that the mail is coming through much faster now, but I still havent gotten ~~the~~ the watch that you sent me. I suppose that it will come eventually. I just hope that it comes before I leave.

I have just returned from an Army PW stockade which I went to to buy some sun glasses. They are the good kind that would cost about \$12 in the states but only cost \$6 here. The Army has much more things to buy in there PX than the Navy in the Ships Store. Nearly all of the POWs have been sent back to ~~Korea~~ Japan.

It is a beautiful spring day here on Okinawa or maybe summer day anyway its a nice day. This is really a beautiful island for scenery; they have some nice beaches here and some pretty flowers. I will take Texas anytime though.

I am enclosing an Roblee add that I took out of the Life magazine, I like the shoes that they have on the top, but would prefer some brown and white like them.

A hundred and fifty low point seabees moved in here yesterday and they will probably be here until the ~~my~~ takes over. I know hardly any of the fellows here who are left here, but I dont care about any thing much since I am going home in just about three more weeks.

I am still hoping that I will be able to go early so that I will make it home in time for discharge but about the only chance that I have is that they want have enough men to fill up a ship and they will have to send us down.

Well I have to go to work now so I suppose that I should close now.
