Dear Folks;
Tommmorow we check out of Headqrs and the next day we head for the USA ,I hope or at least we go down to NOB . A ship came in today and it will take nearly all of the men who are waiting at NOB now home . Another ship is expected in on the 24 and if it comes we will be on our way home before next Sunday. Of course, you never know what will happen , but I am optimistic,at the present. Yesterday was my last day to work and I am off now.

I got serveral letters from you yesterday and the day before ; some of them were old and some were comparatively new . I was,of course, glad to get them . I still havent gotten my watch but , I guess will either get it or get insurance for it sooner or latter.

I am very happy now , but I cant yet realize that I am going home . I guess that the fact that We will have to submit to some pretty rough treatment before being discharged has something to do with the fact that we cant believe that we are going home . And then We have been away so long that we have forgott3n what we are missing .

I keep dribbling along in this letter without anything in particular to write about.

The weather here is preeetty godd today, although it is pretty hot . I ce rtainly hope that you will have the store fixed up with air conditioning when I get home. I know that it will make a big dif ference to you and to the customers .

I think that I want to go to Texas but I might cahnge my mind if it is too crowded.

I dont know where else that I would like to go and would much rather go there if it isnt too crowded.

Nothing much to write about so this may be the last letter that I will write about.

If I have time I will write when at NOB but I dont know so
